Imaamat and Khilafat

- 1. There are two types of Imaamats: Imaamat Sugra and Imaamat Kubra.
- 2. Imaamat Sugra is the Imaamat that is performed in Salaah.
- 3. Imaamat Kubra is in relation to representing the Messenger of Allah (sallal laahu alaihi wasallam).
- 4. To qualify in this category of Imaamat it is necessary that one has the following criteria: He is a Muslim, is free (i.e. not a slave), male, sane, adult, belonging to the tribe of Quraish and one who has power.
- 5. It is not necessary for one to be from the family of the Holy Prophet *(sallal laahu alaihi wasallam)*, i.e. Hashmi, or from the family of Hazrat Ali *(radi Allahu anhu)* i.e. Alawi, or to be Ma'soom (immune from sin). It is also not necessary that one has to be the most virtuous from their nation.
- 6. It is obligatory on all Muslims to obey the Imaam when his orders are not against the Shari'ah (Islamic Law) because one cannot follow anybody's orders if they are against the Shari'ah.
- 7. An Imaam should be made only if he is courageous, a politician and an Islamic scholar (Aalim) or works with the help of Ulema.
- 8. A female or child's Imaamat is not allowed.
